Lancashire Safeguarding is a multi-agency Partnership established to ensure safeguarding measures are met, and that vulnerable children and adults across Lancashire, Blackpool and Blackburn with Darwen are protected from harm, and abuse and lessons are learned from case reviews and improvements identified and implemented.



Child C, D & E CSPR: Published November 29th 2022

Child C and D both died within 7 months of each other in 2013. A number of years later Child E was admitted to hospital after experiencing breathing difficulties at home. The pattern of hospital admissions relating to Child E in conjunction with the histories of the deaths of Child C and Child D resulted in an initiation of a child protection investigation which averted the probable eventual death of Child E. This CSPR highlights both historical and recent good practice and any progress and gaps in local safeguarding systems and practice. View the full report here.

National News

Logan Mwangi CSPR

On 31st July 2021 Logan Mwangi died after suffering from blunt force abdominal injury and cerebral injury.

Recommendations from the CSPR include:

- Ensuring that front line practitioners are aware of their roles in identifying safeguarding concerns and their duty to report.
- Developing guidance for practitioners working to support individuals with Personality Disorders
- Relaunching multi-agency training to include managing Section 47 Child Protection enquiries, identifying and managing suspected Non-Accidental injury, identifying coercive control and managing interagency professional challenge.

<u>The Report of the Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse</u>: the final statutory report has been published and sets out the main findings and recommendations for institutional reform.

<u>Practice improvement resources</u>: The Centre of expertise on child sexual abuse have produced resources aimed at front line practitioners in the education sector to help guide effective responses to child sexual abuse.

<u>Urgent Safety Alert issued for baby self-feeding pillows</u>: The Government has issued an alert about self-feeding pillows/prop feeders presenting a risk of serious hard or death from choking and aspiration pneumonia.
